

Can i use steel filler on veneer cabinet

Filler strips are commonly used to fill in spaces where standard-sized cabinets may not fit perfectly or to accommodate irregularities in the wall or floor. Whether you're ...

Wood fillers can be sanded and stained are best used on unfinished woodwork. Wood putty is best for repairing cracks and small holes on finished woodwork.
