TORONTO - The Ontario government has concluded the largest battery storage procurement in Canada's history and secured the necessary electricity generation to support the province's growing population and economy through the end of the decade.

This means acting now to incorporate long-duration energy storage (LDES) assets, which can store large amounts of electricity for several hours or days and includes technologies such as pumped hydro electric storage, emerging battery storage, thermal storage, or compressed air.

Canada will need a 1,500 per cent increase in battery-based energy storage capacity by 2030 to absorb the expected growth in electricity demand, according to Bloomberg New Energy Finance (BNEF), an industry research group.

The IESO is offering contracts to seven battery storage facilities located throughout the province to provide 739MW of capacity. This is part of an ongoing effort to procure a cumulative 2500MW of energy storage to support the decarbonization and electrification of ...

The governments of Canada and Ontario are working together to build the largest battery storage project in the country. The 250-megawatt (MW) Oneida Energy storage project is being developed in partnership with the Six Nations of the Grand River Development Corporation, Northland Power, NRStor and Aecon Group.

Canada's current installed capacity of energy storage is approximately 1 GW. Per Energy Storage Canada's 2022 report, Energy Storage: A Key Net Zero Pathway in Canada, Canada is going to need at least 8 - 12 GW

to ensure the country reaches its 2035 goals.

6 ????#0183; Several battery energy storage system projects are currently underway in the province, including a 120 megawatt (MW) plant in York region and an 80 MW facility in the municipality of Lakeshore. And by summer 2025, Canada's largest energy storage facility with the capability to hold up to 250 MW of electricity will come online in Jarvis, Ontario.
