

Chile largest bess companies

BESS del Desierto will be among the largest storage contracts in Chile and the first large-scale independent, standalone Battery Energy Storage System (BESS) and will have a storage capacity of 200 MW and hours.

Such is the case of the country's largest solar-plus-storage project from Spanish independent power producer Grenergy and also the world's largest BESS project, according to the company.

This new agreement will provide phase four of the project, which will begin construction in the coming weeks, the company said. Under the deal, CATL will deliver 1.25 GWh of EnerX model containers. The EnerX DC Containerized BESS offers a total energy capacity of over 5.6 MWh in a 20-foot container.

Gabriel Boric Font, Chile's president, attended the launch and hailed the new facility as "a reminder that when we work together a better future awaits us." Engie is the fourth-largest energy generator in Chile and this, its first ...
