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A transmission and offtake agreement for the rehabilitated Djéno plant was signed in May between Aksa and state utility Energie Electrique du Congo (E2C). Indicative of its political importance, the contract was witnessed by energy minister Honoré Sayi and Turkish ambassador Serhan Yigit.

Turkish power company Aksa Enerji has announced plans to boost production at the Djéno gas-to-power plant in the Republic of the Congo to 100 MW. The upgrade will feature the addition of two 25 MW turbines as well as rehabilitation work to the plant's existing two turbines, each with a capacity of 25 MW.
