Does Rarotonga have solar power?

The Cook Islands Electricity Sector All inhabited islands of the Cook Islands currently have centralised power supplies that have historically been powered by diesel generators. Since around 2011, increasing solar PV generation on Rarotonga has changed this situation.

How many islands are in the Cook Islands?

The Cook Islands Located in the South Pacific Ocean, the Cook Islands has 15 islands, of which 12 are inhabited. Most of the Cook Islands 13,000 permanent residents live on Rarotonga, in the south. Aitutaki has a population of approximately 1,800, and remaining islands are sparsely populated. Fig 1.

Where do most people live in the Cook Islands?

Most of the Cook Islands people live in the Southern Islands. Two largest Islands are Rarotonga (main island) and Aitutaki. The Government of the Cook Islands has a long standing policy commitment of 100% renewable electricity by 2020.

New solar plus battery projects in the Cook Islands demonstrate how off-grid regions can transition from reliance on diesel generators

This publication highlights lessons from 26 case studies in the Cook Islands and Tonga. It provides recommendations on improving the implementation of battery energy storage and renewable energy-based hybrid electricity systems.

To support this ambitious plan the Asian Development Bank and the European Union fund the Cook Islands Renewable Energy Sector Project, which will construct up to six solar photovoltaic (PV) power plants with a total installed capacity of about 3 megawatts-peak coupled with battery to store electricity from solar energy.

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The Government of the Cook Islands (GCI) has a policy of 100% renewable energy by 2020. The implementation of this plan is well underway, with renewable energy systems installed at half of the

the Cook Islands Renewable Energy Development Division (REDD). The Phase 1 subprojects will install a total of 1,246 kW of solar PV systems with battery storage. The systems at Mitiaro and Mauke will include new high speed diesel generators whilst the more modern existing diesel power stations on Mangaia and Atiu will be retained.

Three newly commissioned battery systems on Rarotonga which cost US\$16 million (approx. NZ\$24m) will reduce the island's dependence on oil-fuelled power generation and continue the shift to solar power.

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
