The primary vanadium producer has entered into conditional agreement for a complex deal that will effectively increase its holding in Austria-based Enerox, better known by its brand name CellCube, from around 25% to 27.6%.

Who owns enerox?

Bushveld Minerals said in November the consortium, led by its 84%-owned unit Bushveld Energy, would take over Enerox from CellCube Energy Storage Systems Inc for EUR 11 million in a three-part transaction to be executed on a debt free basis.

Does Bushveld own enerox?

Bushveld is among the consortium, Enerox Holdings Limited, that owns Enerox, which makes and markets its energy storage systems from offices in Austria under the brand name Cellcube.
