

Getting started with solar power Norfolk Island

Fresh from the approval of its 600MW project in Cottam, Island Green Power (IGP) has unveiled plans for a 500MW scheme in Norfolk. Early September saw development consent given to the 600MW Cottam Solar Project which will be made up of four electricity generating stations, including ground mounted solar arrays, as well as associated ...

The project is in the early stages of development at present, with the first round of community consultations set to begin this autumn. Island Green Power expects the planning and approval process to take between two and three years, and plans to submit the DCO application to DESNZ in late 2025.
