The Board of Directors of Elektroprivreda Crne Gore (EPCG) has approved the Battery Energy Storage Systems (BESS) project proposal, a crucial initiative aimed at enhancing sustainability, energy efficiency, and system stability. The next step is to issue a public call for a feasibility study and conceptual design for the project. According to the announcement, "The [...]"

EPCG, a utility and distribution network operator (DNO) in the Southeast European country of Montenegro, is looking to add 300MW of BESS to its grid.

BESS technology will enable the storage of surplus energy generated from renewable sources, reducing reliance on fossil fuels and supporting sustainable development. The project plans to use existing grid infrastructure for connecting to the transmission network, with proposed locations including the Hydro Power Plant (HPP) Perucica, EPCG's ...

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In a pioneering move for state-owned utilities in the Balkans, Montenegro's largest power utility, EPCG, is planning to launch a large-scale, battery energy storage procurement exercise by the end of 2024.
