The Mozambique Energy Strategy 2014-2023 intends not only to respond to the challenge presented by EIB of providing power generation scenarios for Mozambique and prioritizing currently proposed investments but also to deliver a road map defining potential paths for gas and power sectors development in Mozambique.

Mozambique has abundant energy sources available for exploitation. As of 2021, the country was ranked first in energy potential of all the countries in the Southern African Power Pool (SAPP), with an estimated energy capacity of 187,000 MW. Available energy sources include coal, hydroelectricity, natural gas, solar energy and wind power. As of ...

Centrica and Tokyo Gas have agreed to jointly purchase 2.6 million tonnes per annum, delivered ex-ship from Mozambique LNG from the start-up of production until the early 2040s.
