Can solar energy replace fossil fuels on Pitcairn Island?

Pitcairn's authorities have launched a renewable energy project designed to replace fossil fuels with solar energy. The goal is to replace 95% of the current diesel consumption on Pitcairn Island (75,000 liters per year) with a combination of energy saving and solar electricity through the installation of a hybrid photovoltaic solar energy system.

Are the Pitcairn Islands Green?

Pitcairn Islands, a group of five islands with a total area of 47 km<sup>2</sup> and which constitute one of the most remote archipelagos in the world, turn to safer, greener energies that best meet the needs of the population. Pitcairn's authorities have launched a renewable energy project designed to replace fossil fuels with solar energy.

What is happening on Pitcairn Island?

On Pitcairn Island, travel restrictions have halted a vital stream of income for the islanders from tourism and cruise ships. In response, Jo McIntosh, Fran Smith and Sue O'Keefe are attempting an 800km walkathon on the island.

What is Pitcairn Island famous for?

Pitcairn Island is famous for being Britain's sole overseas territory in the Pacific and the place where Mutineers from the HMS Bounty, led by Fletcher Christian, settled after setting William Bligh, their captain adrift off Tahiti and stealing the ship. The island has a rugged coastline with steep cliffs and drop-offs.

Are Pitcairn Islanders living in poverty?

While the inhabitants of this small volcanic island are not a part of the 10% living in extreme poverty today, island life is not always a paradise. Pitcairn Islanders are able to live sustainable lives with the help of British financial aid, which amounts to more than \$3 million per year.

How did Pitcairn manage to raise \$5000?

Pitcairn aimed to raise \$5000 to buy more gym equipment for the island. They managed to raise the funds by completing a 'virtual' 128 km walk to Oeno, a coral atoll. As their fitness increased, they completed an additional 40 km, reaching Henderson Island.

Healthcare on Pitcairn Island. Pitcairn has a modern and well-equipped medical clinic and a resident doctor, but the nearest hospital facilities are at least 2 days away by boat, in Tahiti or New ...

The Pitcairn Islands Marine Reserve, one of the largest on Earth, was established in March 2015 after years of collaborative efforts. Beginning in 2011, the Pew Environment Group's Global Ocean Legacy project worked with the Pitcairn islanders to create this marine sanctuary. In 2012, a National Geographic expedition assessed
