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The PV plant, which increased Rwanda's generation capacity by 6%, is situated 60km from the capital of Kigali, on land owned by the Agahozo-Shalom Youth Village (ASYV) for youth orphaned during and after the 1994 Rwandan genocide.

The overall objective of this project was to develop a 10MW solar PV plant in Rwanda. OBJECTIVES. Rwanda has a total installed generation capacity of 110 MW and only 19.4% of the population have access to it. Also, 43% of the generation capacity is mostly fueled by diesel, giving Rwanda one of the highest costs of electricity in the region.

Kigali, Rwanda (Lat/Long -1.9507, 30.0663) is well-suited for solar PV generation due to its location within the Tropics, where seasons are primarily distinguished by wet and dry periods rather than temperature fluctuations. Consequently, this region experiences consistent sunlight for most of the year, resulting in substantial electricity ...
