

How much solar energy does South Sudan have?

South Sudan receives about 8 hours of sunshine daily, providing an estimated solar energy capacity of 436W/M2/year(REEP,2013). Similarly, wind energy density ranges between 285 and 380 W/M2 (REEP,2013). Both the solar sunshine duration and wind density meet the threshold required to produce high quality electricity.

How much power does South Sudan need?

South Sudan's installed power capacity is about 130 megawatts, a large chunk of which is used to supply electricity to the country's abundant oil fields. However, the country's power demand is about 300 megawatts, an amount that's likely to grow during peacetime, Deng said. "We are actually thirsty [for generation]," he said.

Why is energy infrastructure underdeveloped in South Sudan?

Partly due to the civil wars(e.g.,1955-1972,1983-2005 &2013-present), energy infrastructure remains very underdeveloped in South Sudan. Despite a peace agreement in 2015, which has been revitalized recently, conflict has impeded the country's effort in transitioning to renewable energy.

Should subsidies be removed for solar & wind energy in South Sudan?

Subsidies have been crucial in the development of any energy sources, including oil and coal in the early stages of development. So, removing subsidies particularly on fuel for generators would level the investment ground for solar and wind energy in South Sudan.

How many people in South Sudan have electricity?

Today, only about 1 percent of South Sudan's 12.5 million people can access the electric grid, according to the state-run utility. Many people use rooftop solar arrays or noisy, polluting diesel generators to keep the lights on; still many more are left in the dark.

Does South Sudan need electricity to drive industrial development?

Electricity prices in South Sudan are twice the prices of electricity in Africa and are five times the prices in other developing countries (Ranganathan and Briceno-Garmendia,2011). As a resource rich country that needs to attract direct foreign investment, South Sudan definitely needs power to drive industrial development.

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Since 2018, the Revitalized Agreement between the key players in South Sudan's long-running civil war has provided a framework for peace, the Head of the UN mission there, UNMISS, told the Security Council on Friday - "despite continued outbreaks of intercommunal violence".
