

What is the Syrian Civil War?

The Syrian civil war is an ongoing internal violent conflict in Syria. It is a part of the wider Arab Spring, a wave of upheaval throughout the Arab World. Public demonstrations across Syria began on 26 January 2011 and developed into a nationwide uprising.

Where is Syria located?

Syria, [a]officially the Syrian Arab Republic, [b]is a country in West Asia located in the Eastern Mediterranean and the Levant. Within the region of the Middle East, it is bounded by the Mediterranean Sea to the west, Turkey to the north, Iraq to the east and southeast, Jordan to the south, and Israel and Lebanon to the southwest.

What's happening in Syria?

A surprise offensive by rebel forces opposing Syrian President Bashar al-Assad's regime has led to a new round of fighting in the Middle Eastern country's long-running - but until recently largely static - civil war. After a lightning advance in just a few days, rebels captured almost all of Aleppo, which is Syria's second-largest city.

Is Syria a frozen War?

AL-NAYRAB, Syria (AP) -- For years, Syria's civil war has been a largely frozen conflict, the country effectively carved up into areas controlled by the Damascus government of President Bashar Assad, various opposition groups and Syrian Kurdish forces.

Is Syria a corrupt country?

Syria is the most corrupt country in the Middle East and North Africa and was ranked the 2nd lowest globally on the 2023 Corruption Perceptions Index. The country has also become the epicentre of a state-sponsored multi-billion dollar illicit drug cartel, the largest in the world.

Why is Syria called Syria?

The name "Syria" historically referred to a wider region, broadly synonymous with the Levant, and known in Arabic as al-Sham. The modern state encompasses the sites of several ancient kingdoms and empires, including the Eblan civilization of the 3rd millennium BC. Damascus and Aleppo are cities of great cultural significance.
