

Tokelau 2kva off grid solar system

Work started in mid-June 2012 on the one megawatt Tokelau Renewable Energy Project, which is comprised of three individual solar power systems with battery storage. Each system alone is among the largest off-grid solar power systems in the world, and together they are capable of providing 150% of current electricity demand in Tokelau, a much ...

Tokelau - located just south of the equator, with nearly constant solar irradiation year-round - is an ideal candidate for photovoltaics. The three atolls of Fakaofu, Nukunono and Atafu now operate their own hybrid systems. With 1 megawatt of total power, the plants generate more energy than the 1,411 inhabitants of Tokelau need.

The Tokelau Renewable Energy Project (TREP) saw the installation of solar diesel hybrid power systems on Fakaofu, Nukunono and Atafu, the three atolls of Tokelau. There is a clear need across the community to better understand the reasoning behind tariffs and what different tariffs mean for the community

Mount Maunganui-based Powersmart Solar is the lead contractor in a renewable energy project to see Tokelau replace its diesel electricity systems with solar power systems and battery...

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new solar power systems replaced the existing diesel systems and were designed to provide at least 90% of the islands' electricity needs, saving roughly NZD 900,000 per year in diesel costs. In fact, expectation has been exceeded and Tokelau is the first country to have almost all its electricity needs met by solar power. WHO FUNDED THE PROJECT?

These systems are part of the Tokelau Renewable Energy Project that has been funded by the New Zealand government and represents one of the largest off-grid renewable energy projects in the world. With this project, the islands will make the transition from being completely dependent on imported fuels to being completely energy independent.

Consisting of 4,032 photovoltaic panels and 1,344 batteries with generators running on biofuel derived from coconuts, the \$7.5 million Tokelau Renewable Energy Project is considered one of the world's largest off-grid



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solar systems. Tokelau, which has a total land mass of just 4.7 square miles and a population of about 1,500, previously relied ...

The South Pacific nation of Tokelau became the first country in the world to have all of its electricity needs met by solar power. Designed by Powersmart Solar in partnership with ITP Renewables, construction of the combined 1 MW of stand-alone PV spread across the three atolls was completed in October 2012.
