The Solar Farm is capable of producing 6.9MWp of renewable power, helping lower power costs to Tonga and producing enough renewable energy to offset 18% of Tongatapu's current diesel-powered generation.

OIREP, a multi-donor project led by the Asian Development Bank and co-financed by the Australian Government, European Union and Green Climate Fund is helping Tonga reduce its dependence on imported fossil fuels for power generation by constructing solar power plants on outer islands.

Sunergise will finance, build and operate the 6-megawatt solar farm on Tongatapu and sell the electricity generated to Tonga Power for 25-years. The solar plant is expected to begin operations by April 2020.

Tonga Power Limited (TPL) signed the power purchase agreement with Sunergise New Zealand Limited (Sunergise), which will finance, build, and operate the 6-megawatt solar farm on Tongatapu and sell the electricity generated to TPL for 25 years.

Our main source of renewable energy is currently from solar generation and wind generation, but we are also looking into other renewable energy sources that are reliable and sustainable here in Tonga.

Comprising three interconnected 2.3MWp ground mounted solar arrays in western Tongatapu, the construction phase successfully met the extreme challenges presented by the 2022 Hunga Tonga-Hunga Ha'apai volcanic eruption and resulting tsunami, as well as the COVID-19 pandemic.
