Where is TSMC made?

This Phoenix, Arizona semiconductor fabrication facility will be the most-advanced on U.S. soil with a more than 20,000 chip wafer-per-month production capacity. As one of the most important semiconductor pioneers, TSMC is relied on by the world's best-known brands and savviest start-ups to bring their designs to life.

What is TSMC Arizona?

This represents the largest foreign direct investment in the state of Arizona, and one of the largest ever in the United States. TSMC Arizona will create 4500 high-tech, high-wage jobs, and it's expected that expansions by semiconductor industry suppliers will bring thousands more employment opportunities to the region.

What makes TSMC unique?

Through the vision and leadership of its founder Dr. Morris Chang, TSMC pioneered the pure-play semiconductor foundry business model. TSMC has since remained one of the world's largest dedicated foundries with fabrication facilities ("fabs") and subsidiaries spanning Asia, Europe and North America.

What did TSMC Arizona do in 2024?

Then in April 2024, the U.S. Department of Commerce and TSMC Arizona announced up to US\$6.6 billion in direct funding under the CHIPS and Science Act, fulfilling a goal to bring the most advanced chip manufacturing in the world to the United States. TSMC also announced plans to build a third fab at TSMC Arizona.

What is TSMC water recycling & reclamation?

Two important aspects of our approach are water recycling and water reclamation: At startup, approximately 65% of the water used in the Arizona operation will come from TSMC's in-house water recycling systems. The recycled water will be used in systems such as our air scrubbers and cooling tower systems.
